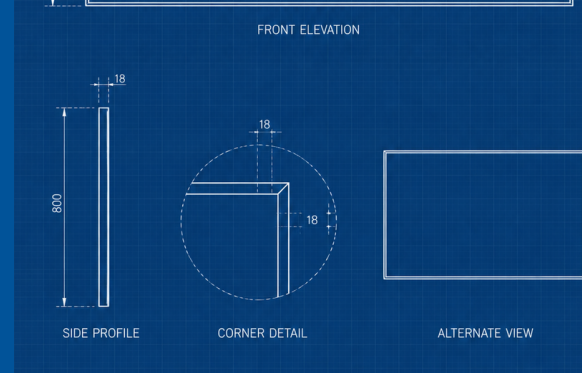

LX8 Edge Frame Writing Board

Overview

These instructions show you how to mount an EDGE FRAME to a wall using the install baton (top rail), then fit the pen tray and the two safety brackets (bottom locks).

Before You Start

- Decide whether the frame will be mounted portrait (tall) or landscape (wide). Use the matching install baton.
- Confirm your wall type:
 - Brick/Cement (masonry)
 - Gyprock/Plaster (plasterboard)
- If you're mounting to plasterboard, make sure you use proper wall anchors rated for the load (or fix into studs if available).
- Plan the mounting height so the pen tray is comfortable to reach.

Tools You'll Need

- Spirit level
- Measuring tape
- Pencil
- Drill/driver
- Drill bits to suit your wall type (masonry bit for brick/cement; suitable bit for plasterboard anchors)
- Safety glasses

Parts Included

- Install baton for portrait mounting (x1)
- Install baton for landscape mounting (x1)
- Pen tray (x1)
- Safety brackets (x2)
- Screws: 40 mm (x5), 35 mm (x5), 30 mm (x5), 15 mm (x2)

What to Check

- The wall is flat and solid (no loose render, crumbling mortar, or soft plaster).
- You have enough clearance to lift the frame up and lower it onto the baton.
- You can drill safely (no hidden services where you're drilling).
- You can keep the install baton perfectly level (this determines whether the frame sits straight).

Safety Notes

- Lift with two people if the frame is large/heavy.
- Wear eye protection when drilling.
- Don't overtighten screws into plasterboard anchors (you can strip them).

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Select the correct install baton.

- Use the portrait baton for a tall orientation, or the landscape baton for a wide orientation.
- **Check:** The baton matches the way you want the frame to sit.

2. Hold the install baton against the wall at your chosen height.

- Position it where the top of the frame needs to hang.
- **Check:** You can comfortably reach the baton and drill points.

3. Level the install baton.

- Place a spirit level on the baton and adjust until level.
- **Check:** The level bubble is centred.

4. Mark all baton fixing holes.

- Keep the baton in place and mark each hole location with a pencil.
- **Check:** Marks are clear and evenly spaced along the baton.

5. Drill the marked holes.

- Brick/Cement: drill with a masonry bit to suit your wall plugs.
- Gyprock/Plaster: drill to suit your chosen plasterboard anchors.
- **Warning:** Drill straight; don't angle the holes.
- **Check:** Each hole lines up with the baton holes.

6. Install wall fixings (if required).

- Brick/Cement: insert wall plugs fully into the holes.
- Gyprock/Plaster: install plasterboard anchors according to the anchor instructions.
- **Check:** Fixings sit flush and feel secure.

7. **Screw the install baton to the wall.**

- Drive screws through the baton into the wall fixings.
- Tighten until snug; do not overtighten.
- **Check:** The baton does not rock or flex, and it is still level.

8. **Hang the frame on the install baton.**

- With two people if needed, lift the frame up to the baton.
- Hook the top of the frame over the baton and lower it until it seats fully.
- **Check:** The frame is sitting flush and supported along the top; it shouldn't wobble.

9. **Fit the pen tray.**

- Slide the pen tray into the bottom channel of the frame until fully seated.
- **Check:** The tray sits straight and doesn't slide out easily.

10. **Position the two safety brackets.**

- Place one bracket near each lower corner on the back/bottom area (as designed to stop the frame lifting off the baton).
- Orient each bracket so it can be fixed to the wall and also capture/lock the lower edge of the frame.
- **Check:** Both brackets sit flat and are symmetrical left/right.

11. **Mark the bracket fixing points.**

- With the frame in its final position, mark the wall through the bracket holes.
- Use the specified 28.4 mm bracket measurement where applicable (follow the bracket's built-in offset/spacing as intended).
- **Check:** Both brackets will pull the bottom edge in evenly.

12. **Drill and install fixings for the brackets.**

- Drill the marked holes and install plugs/anchors to suit the wall type (as in Steps 5–6).
- **Warning:** Keep the frame stable while drilling/marking so it can't slip.
- **Check:** Fixings are secure and aligned with the bracket holes.

13. **Secure the safety brackets.**

- Screw each bracket into the wall fixings. Tighten until snug.
- Install the small screws (15 mm) where required to lock the bracket to the frame.
- **Check:** You cannot lift the bottom of the frame away from the wall.

Finishing Checks

- Frame is level and sits flat against the wall.
- Install baton is firmly fixed (no movement).
- Safety brackets are fitted and tight, preventing lift-off.
- Pen tray is fully seated and straight.

Troubleshooting

Frame isn't level

- The install baton is not level. Loosen the baton screws slightly, re-level, then retighten.

Baton feels loose

- Incorrect wall fixings or over-drilled holes. Replace with correct plugs/anchors for your wall type.

Frame won't seat on the baton

- The frame may not be lifted high enough before lowering onto the baton, or the baton orientation may be wrong. Remove the frame and re-seat carefully.

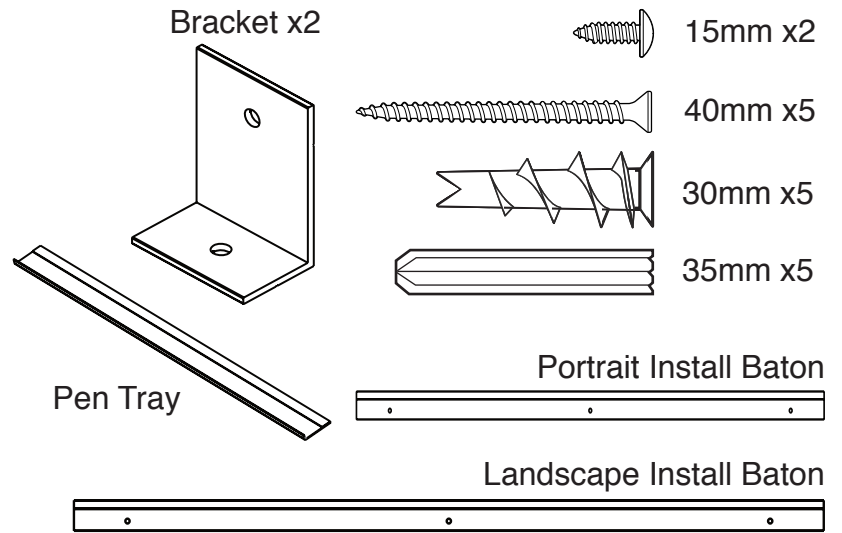
Pen tray won't slide in

- Check it's aligned with the bottom channel and that brackets aren't blocking the channel area.

Bottom can still lift away

- Brackets may be reversed, not tight, or the small locking screws are missing.

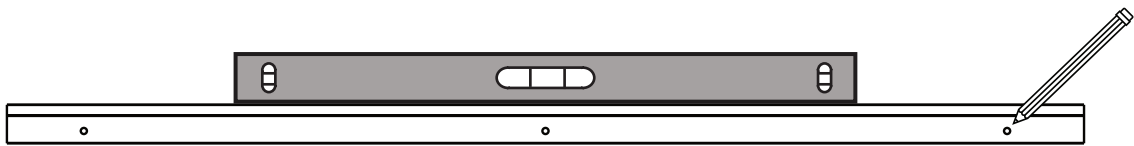
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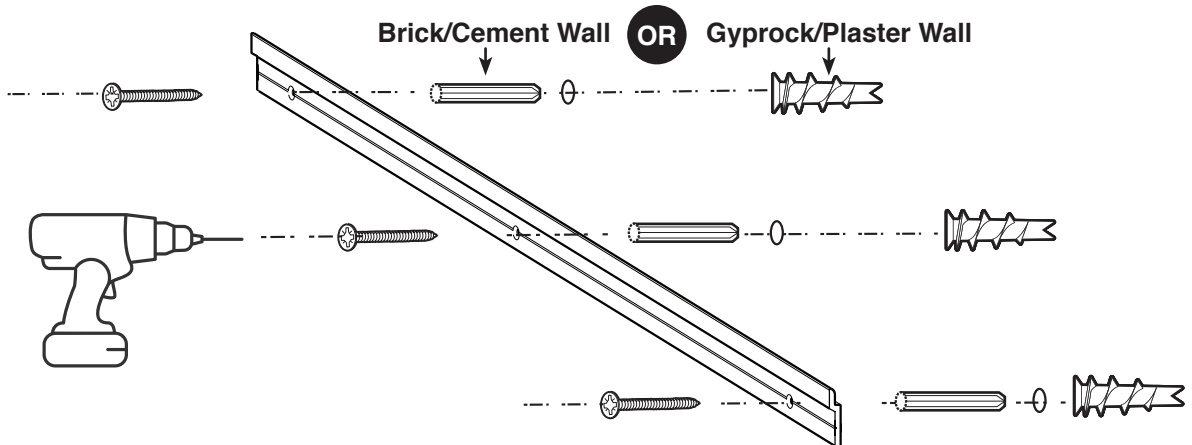
